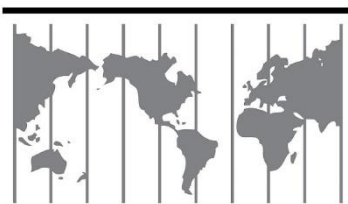

Over the course of its storied past, the Tower has changed ownership and roles multiple times; it has been a prison, treasury, army, museum and more. Today, it houses the crowned jewels and thousands of eager visitors. Your guide recounts the legends and facts, walking you in the footsteps of past prisoners and esteemed royals.

Day 7: Tuesday, June 27, 2023 London - Greenwich - London Peek into the city's storied past with a visit to the Tower of London, uncovering the secrets of this 11th-century fortress. Then, see the Tower from a different perspective and hop on a cruise along the River Thames to Greenwich. Explore Greenwich Market, a lively collection of local stalls, specialty treats, and charming venues for lunch and shopping. Test your seafaring prowess onboard the *Cutty Sark*, a Victorian-style ship that served as a tea clipper. Tonight, gather for a farewell dinner at a favorite London pub and toast the end of a wonderful getaway. (B, D)

The overall activity level of this tour is a level 3. This means you're an on-the-go traveler. You don't want to miss a thing, so walking and standing for longer periods of time (1-2 hours) isn't a big deal. You can navigate hills and uneven ground, climb into various modes of transportation (tuk-tuk, cable car, Zodiac, etc.), and could possibly anticipate changes in elevation. You can expect some longer days balanced with free-time to recharge or set out on your own adventure.
